

WHAT IS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE?

Any act that one person uses to dominate and control another person in an intimate relationship

PHYSICAL ABUSE

- physical injuries
- withholding access to health resources
- coercion and threats
- property damage

EMOTIONAL ABUSE

- put downs
- humiliation
- degradation
- ignoring your thoughts or feelings

ECONOMICAL ABUSE

- preventing from getting/keeping job
- taking/controlling money

SEXUAL ABUSE

- unwanted sexual contact
- treating victim like a sex object
- coercion and threats

PSYCHOLOGICAL ABUSE

- fear
- isolation
- jealousy or possessiveness
- using your children against you
